- b. New CoVid case procedures



Growth and Achievement Plan – Numeracy and Literacy Committees,

LITERACY Committee: Asked the questions - What is something we'd like to look at in the area of writing and in the area of reading. Teachers are noticing a hesitancy of students to engage in writing tasks. Recognizing need for confidence and perseverance in writing. What ways can we nurture confidence and perseverance in writing? How do we help with the pre-writing?

How do we encourage students to nurture the reading lives of students? Looking at ways to make reading a community experience. One idea was "I love reading" month. How do we share the love of books that we have?

NUMERACY Committee: Teachers reviewed the pre-assessment data from late September. Teachers identified areas to zone in on such as fractions, graphing, and problem solving. The Numeracy Committee will be following the works of Peter Liljedahl.
