  - a. Principal's report Darryl Christiansen (Principal Grade 8 Administrator)

    - ii. Remembrance Day assembly thank you Remembrance Day assembly was held virtually on November 10<sup>th</sup> with student involvement and special guest from the Canadian Military.
    - iii. Nov. 9th Social Media presentation November 9<sup>th</sup> Social Media presentation with Ted Emmett. He did a student presentation in the morning and a parent presentation in the evening. He encourages use of the acronym THINK (Is it true, honest, illegal,

- iv. CoVid Notification procedures Covid notification procedures two cases in 2 days recently which prompted letters home to entire school population and all school cohorts impacted. No action taken unless more than 3 positive cases within one cohort.
- v. Fine Arts / athletics update -
  - 1. Fine arts winter concerts December 14<sup>th</sup> for choir and December 16<sup>th</sup> for band. Building capacity and current Covid protocols are being used to determine attendance. Information will be shared in the next week.
  - Athletics volleyball season just finished and rec boys won the championship! Girl's team lost in the semi-finals.

- b. Matt Brunner (Acting Vice Principal Grade 7 Administrator)
  - i. Term 1 completion, Term 2 options Term 2 starts November 29<sup>th</sup>. Administrators check on marks upon completion of term 1 and the storing of grades happens December 3<sup>rd</sup>. This allows admin to generate honour role.
  - ii. Term 2 options options are tight with student numbers, but parents can email administrator and Matt will look into whether a change is possible. This does have to be initiated by parents. Every attempt is made to accommodate change requests.
  - iii. Middle School Reporting email will be upcoming re: what ongoing/continuous reporting means for students. There is not a summative end of term comment because this should be done on a regular basis, on at least 3 of the assignments throughout the term.
- c. Catherine Thorsen (Vice Principal Grade 6 Administrator)
  - i. Enrolment and new students and families 75 80 new students since the start of the school year (2-3 students on average).
  - ii. Assurance Plan Review/ Update Staff Inquiry-Based Learning
  - iii. Student Learning Supports Numeracy / Literacy Language Arts and Social Studies teachers are looking at how they can bring love back to reading and spark perseverance and confidence. Looking at community experience of readers, read-alouds, Drop Everything and Read (DEAR) program. Supporting student writing is another area of focus to help students learn to start or initiative the writing

- process. Numeracy -teachers are looking at inspiring students to build confidence in numeracy and rich thinking tasks.
