Gilbert Paterson Grade 6 Provincial Achievement Test (PAT) Results – June 2017

Below are the results of our June Provincial Achievement Tests. This was the first year for a Math Part A in the province at grade 6, which was a timed 15 question test of math skills. Administration and teachers reflect on the detailed results of these tests to look at specific areas of strength as well as outcomes that can be addressed. We also look to see if there are trends developing or if a result is an anomaly. This process is an important part of continuous school improvement.
