Now is the time of year when Grade 8 students and parents are making important decisions about the next school year. Lethbridge School District No. 51 has five excellent high schools offering programs for students in grades 9 to 12:

- Chinook High School (CHS), located in west Lethbridge, offers a full range of high school programs, including a University Extension program.
- Immanuel Christian Secondary School (ICSS), located in north Lethbridge, offers a full range of high school programs in a Christian educational environment.
- Lethbridge Collegiate Institute (LCI), located in south Lethbridge, offers a full range of high school programs, including French Immersion and University Dual Credit programs.
- Victoria Park High School (VPHS) provides a variety of programs to high school students from across the city. For Grade 9 students, entrance to Victoria Park is by
- Winston Churchill High School (WCHS), located in north Lethbridge, offers a full range of high school programs, including the International Baccalaureate Program.

Attached you will find a summary of very important orientation dates for CHS, LCI, ICSS and WCHS. Each school will host one parent evening for providing general information about their school. Included in the information evenings for CHS, LCI, ICSS and WCHS will be descriptions of the advanced academic programs for university-bound students that the schools offer, including the International Baccalaureate (IB) program at WCHS, the University Dual Credit opportunity at LCI and the University Extension program at CHS. To find out more about the advanced academic opportunities available to you in Lethbridge School District #51, I would encourage you to attend the information nights and to visit the school websites (www.wchs.lethsd.ab.ca, www.chs.lethsd.ab.ca, www.lci.lethsd.ab.ca). Regardless of which school your child plans to attend, you are most welcome to come to any or all of the orientation meetings for these four high schools.

Any high school student can attend a school other than their neighbourhood school, provided there is room at the school they choose. In order to enable schools time to plan for innovative programs and services based upon student interest, we are asking students to register by April 29th, 2019.

With respect to transportation to and from school, the District's bussing policy is based on provincial funding guidelines.

- Students who **live beyond 2.4 kilometres from their boundary school** will be transported by way of Yellow School Bus or City Transit Breeze Card (WCHS).
- Students who wish to attend a school of choice and live beyond 2.4 kilometres
 from their boundary school and their school of choice will be transported by way
 of a City Transit Breeze Card.
- Students who live **less than 2.4 kilometres from their boundary** school are not eligible for transportation.
