## Reporting Student Absences - Did You Know?

The Safe Arrival *Mobile App* is a quick and painless way to enter your child's absence. Once you've downloaded the App, you are just a few 'taps' away from logging current and future absences, lates, and early dismissals. We know that sometimes 'life' gets in the way and you may have forgotten, or not been able, to report an absence. At a pre-determined time (usually between 10 AM and 11 AM) Safe Arrival will send out automated notices to the student's first and second contact. Although these calls may seem intrusive, they are designed to *ensure the safety of your child*. *Please note the calls will stop once you've listened to the whole message and responded accordingly*. You do not need to follow up with the school. A report will be generated and your information will automatically be sent to the office.
