What is Theme V?

As authorized by Lethbridge School District 51 and Alberta Education, students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will participate in classes designed to provide information on Human Sexuality (Growth and Development). Teachers follow provincially mandated curriculum guidelines and have been trained to ensure that the school is providing an effective program that is sensitive to your child's needs. These classes will typically take place during Health classes in the month of January.

What are the Theme V Learner Outcomes?

Grade 8 students will:

- Identify and describe the responsibilities and consequences associated with involvement in a sexual relationship.
- Describe symptoms, effects, treatments and prevention for common sexually transmitted infections; e.g. chlamydia, HPV, herpes, gonorrhea, hepatitis B/C.
- Identify and describe basic types of contraceptives; e.g. abstinence, condoms, foam, and the birth control pill.
- Recognize and accept that individuals experience different rates of physical, emotional, sexual, and social development.
- Determine the signs, methods, and consequences of various types of abuse.
