Evaluation

This appears to be an area of growth for our school. Based on further drill down of the results we can see that caretakers feel disconnected from what is going on at the school by often answering "I don't know" to what is happening with their children. There is an increase in positive responses from teachers overall. Students seem to feel that others are not following the rules. We hope to improve this area by improving parent communication and supporting students to support each other through hard times. We are focusing on this with our new common purpose of empathy, connection, and resiliency.

Evaluation

Again in looking into detailed response, it appears that more than 60% of our students feel that they take responsibility for their actions and that they believe students follow the rules which is positive.

We have not changed much in this area over the last few years. I think it is very promising that adults (including parents and staff) feel that their students are receiving challenging and meaningful work. An area of growth for us is how students perceive the work in grade 7. More than half of our students feel that the work is challenging and interesting, but this is an area we will continue to invest in. We hope that through our numeracy and literacy groups we will find meaningful ways to connect with curriculum so that more students feel connected to what they are learning.
